

# JUNIOR TEAM SELECTION POLICY

### **Our Commitment**

We believe that junior domestic sport should be safe, enjoyable, inclusive and maximise individual participation. Our club acknowledges that positive experiences in junior competition will contribute to children developing a lifelong love of sport.

### **Team Selection Process**

- Prior to the start of each summer season a "grading session" is held where the
  players participate in a training session along with selectors and current coaches to
  undertake of number of drills that will display their skill, basketball IQ and
  coachability.
- Selected teams generally remain unchanged for the 12 month period, through Summer and the following Winter season, however this depends on player registration numbers and cannot be guaranteed.
- We aim to select teams across as many divisions as possible within each age level (from Division 1-4).
- Players will be selected for teams based on a combination of their skill and size to make a well-rounded team. Teams require a balance of guards, forwards and centres.
- Player growth and progress from the previous season will be considered as some children develop faster than others.
- Selecting teams is a very lengthy process and one that takes our volunteers countless hours. Selectors have vast basketball experience and knowledge of the competition. Individual PlayHQ results will not determine team placement.
- Any request to change teams must be approved by the age level coaching group and club Registrar.

## What we will do

- Communicate dates of grading sessions to all junior members, providing as much notice as possible.
- Try to place players in teams with others of their own ability.
- Provide players with a range of experiences and opportunities.
- Emphasise to coaches and parents that junior sports is about participation, not competition.
- Encourage equal playing time for all players, regardless of their ability.
- Ensure all team members play in finals if qualified.

# Coaches

- Focus on promoting participation, not winning and losing.
- Ensure all team members have the chance to play, rotate positions and receive equal playing time.
- Be fair and treat all team members the same.

#### **Parents**

- Focus on your child's effort and performance, not the score.
- Encourage your child and all team members.
- Respect the selection decisions of the coach.
